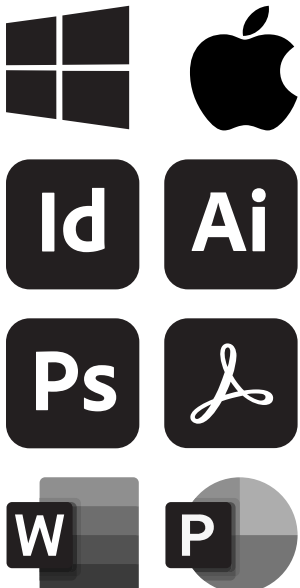
Graduated with a B.A. in Fine Arts with an emphasis in Graphic Design, Francis Marion University in 2007.
